ADMISSION CIRCULAR

Applications are invited for admissions under RTE Act to class I and other Non-DAE(ND-1 to ND-4) categories to classes I, II & VI in AECS-1 & 2 Jaduguda for the session 2019-2020 against the seats available as given below:

General information:

1. Admissions under RTE Act will be granted **only** to class I.
2. There will be **no admission test** for the students seeking admissions to classes I,II & VI.
3. Admissions under RTE Act and other Non- DAE categories at Jaduguda will be regulated centrally at AECS-1, Jaduguda. **Admission Forms for both the schools i.e. AECS-1 and AECS-2, Jaduguda will be issued at AECS-1, Jaduguda.**
4. The grant of Non-DAE admissions is subject to availability of seats in respective classes after completion of DAE and RTE admissions (Class I) in the respective AEC Schools.

Children admitted under Non-DAE category at Jaduguda will be subject to admission in either of the schools (AECS-1 or AECS-2) as per the availability of the seats and may be subject to change at any time as per the discretion of the Chairman, LMC.

Mere issue and acceptance of Admission Form will not guarantee Non-DAE admission to the applicants. Hence, Non-DAE parents are advised not to wholly depend on AEEs for admissions.

5. AGE

The **eligible minimum and maximum age as on 31.03.19** for admission in classes I, II & VI are as follows:

Note: Children who were born on or after 01.04.2012 and on or before 31.03.2014 residing in the neighbourhood area, who belong to Disadvantaged Group and/or Weaker section are eligible to seek admission under the provisions of RTE Act, 2009.

6. ADMISSION FORM

Admission forms for students seeking admission under RTE/Non-DAE wards can be obtained from the AECS-1, Jaduguda school office by paying a fee of **Rs.100/-** . However, this fee will not be charged from the applicants under RTE Act.

Separate admission forms need to be submitted if the admission is sought under more than one category, i.e RTE and other Non-DAE categories. (ND-1 to ND-4).

Application Form can be downloaded from AEES website: **www.aees.gov.in**. The duly filled in form along with a fee of Rs.100/- should be submitted to AECS-1, Jaduguda school office.

8. Fee:

a) Fee for students seeking admission under RTE:

No fee will be charged for students admitted under RTE in class I till they complete class VIII, however the employees who have the facility of fee reimbursement in their department can't claim RTE concessions.

b) Fee for students seeking admission under Non-DAE categories :

Fees will be charged for twelve months of an academic year at the time of admission:

Fee Concession for Non-DAE students:

- i)** All Non-DAE students whose parents are Below Poverty Line (BPL) are exempted from payment of tuition fee alone subject to their submission of a valid certificate issued by a competent authority.
- ii)** All Non-DAE students belonging to SC/ST whose parents are Below Poverty Line (BPL) are exempted from payment of tuition fee alone subject to their submission of a valid certificate issued by a competent authority.
- iii)** All Non-DAE students (boys and girls) whose parents (both father and mother) combined annual income is less than Rs.1,50,000/- per annum (subject to their submission of a valid certificate issued by a competent authority) will be granted fee concession to the extent of 50% of revised tuition fee for Non-DAE students. However, such tuition fee concession should not result into less than the tuition fee

prescribed for the wards of DAE employees. In other words, the Non-DAE students who avail 50% of revised tuition fees concession are required to pay a minimum of Rs.900 per month as prescribed for DAE students.

I. FOR ADMISSIONS UNDER RTE ACT

A. Method of admission under RTE ACT

- i) No admission test will be conducted for the students seeking admission to class I. If the number of applicants seeking admission to Class I under the provisions of RTE Act is more than the seats available, selection will be made by a draw of lots in presence of parents.
- ii) Preference in admission will be given to children residing within 1 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda. If sufficient number of children are not available within 1 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda, children residing within an extended limit i.e. within 3 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda will be considered for admission. If the seats are still vacant, children residing within 6 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda will be considered.

B. Eligibility for grant of admission to Class I under the provisions of RTE Act.

Children residing in the neighbourhood area who belong to Disadvantaged Group and /or Weaker Section as per Jharkhand Govt. notification are eligible to seek admission under the provisions of RTE Act, 2009.

DEFINITION OF DISADVANTAGED GROUP /WEAKER SECTION / NEIGHBOURHOOD

a) Definition of disadvantaged group

1. “Child belonging to disadvantaged group” means a child belonging to the Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe, the socially and educationally backward class or such other group having disadvantage owing to social, cultural, economic, geographical, linguistic, gender or such other factor as may be specified by the Jharkhand government, by notification.
2. “Child with special needs and suffering from disability” will be determined as per the provision mentioned in RTE Act 2009 or as defined by the Govt. of Jharkhand.

b) Definition of weaker section

“Child belonging to weaker section” means a child belonging to such a parent or guardian (declared by a Court or a Statute) whose annual income is lower than the minimum limit specified by the Jharkhand government, by notification.

The income limit regarding economically weaker sections will be applicable as notified by the Govt. of Jharkhand.

c) Definition of neighbourhood

The residence of the child should be within 1 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda. If sufficient number of children are not available within 1 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda, children residing within an extended limit i.e. within 3 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda will be considered for admission. If the seats are still vacant, children residing within 6 km radius (shortest distance) from AECS-1/2 boundary wall Jaduguda will be considered.

d) Proof of residence

Proof of residence shall have to be produced by all the applicants.

Documents required to be submitted with filled in application forms for admission under RTE Act

Attested copies of the following documents are required to be submitted along with filled in application form and originals at the time of admission in the respective school office where admission is granted under the provisions of RTE Act.

1. For Class-I, certificate of proof of age in the form of original birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council / Municipality / Municipality Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat endorsed under the seal and signature of the Revenue / Panchayat officer of the concerned area. **Admission will not be granted on the basis of an affidavit in lieu of a birth certificate.**
2. A certificate that the child belongs to the Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / EWS / OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/ BPL / Differently-abled, wherever applicable, issued by the competent authority of concerned State Government/ Union Government. The certificate in respect of either of the parents may be accepted initially, for the purpose of admission, if this certificate is not available for the child. However, the certificate in respect of the child has to be submitted within a period of 3 months from the date of admission.
3. A certificate from the civil surgeon / rehabilitation centre or any other competent authority defined by the Government of India certifying the child to be handicapped, wherever applicable.
4. Attested copies of Aadhar card/ Ration card of parents along with the name of the child.
5. Income certificate issued by the employer concerned / Revenue authorities in respect of parents of all categories of applicants.

6. **Proof of residence (essential)** and distance from the school will be taken from Caste Certificate / Aadhar Card / Voter ID / MNREGA Card / Ration Card / Driving License / Electricity Bill containing address of the child / parent.

7. Any other document(s) as advised / required by the Principal.

II. FOR ADMISSIONS UNDER OTHER NON-DAE CATEGORIES

A) Method of admission

No admission test will be conducted for the students seeking admission to class I, II & VI. Admission will be granted subject to approval from the competent authority in AEES.

B) AVAILABILITY OF SEATS

Non-DAE admissions under categories from ND – 1 to ND - 4 will be considered subject to the availability of seats. **The vacancies are tentative and may change. Parents are advised not to wholly depend on AEES for admissions. Mere issue and acceptance of admission forms will not guarantee Non-DAE admission to the applicants.**

C) CATEGORIES OF NON-DAE WARDS & ELIGIBILITY FOR SEEKING ADMISSIONS AGAINST VACANT SEATS

Category Code	Description
ND-1	Wards of Project Affected people, whose land has been acquired for the DAE project (applicable only for first generation)
ND-2	Wards of Central/ State Govt./ PSU Employees engaged in DAE (e.g Sausheelya, Mehatva, School for special children, Co-operative Credit Society, Banks, Post office etc.) and the wards of the employees of contractors working for DAE projects and Wards of defence / Paramilitary Personnel or wards of their widows.
ND-3	Grandchildren of serving/retired or expired DAE employees (One admission per employee).Grandchildren of AEES employees (serving/retired or expired) will have preference.
ND-4	Wards of people residing around DAE establishment.

D) DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR ADMISSION

- i.** For Class-I, certificate of proof of age in the form of original birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council / Municipality / Municipality Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat endorsed under the seal and signature of the Revenue / Panchayat officer of the concerned area. **Admission will not be granted on the basis of an affidavit in lieu of a birth certificate.**
- ii. For other classes:** A valid and original Transfer Certificate (TC) from the school last attended as per the guidelines issued by CBSE.

For II –XII: Those seeking admission to any class from II to XII will be required to submit a valid and original Transfer Certificate (TC) from the school last attended. The TC produced should be appended with the signature of the Principal/Vice-Principal (if Principal is not available). If the place of birth is not indicated in the TC of the

previous school, the proof of place of birth of the child is to be produced. In case of students migrating from CBSE affiliated/State Board School, the TC needs to be counter signed by the concerned Education Officer.

iii. Other documents required under categories ND - 1 to ND - 4

1. Parents of wards who belong to ND-1 Category should submit relevant documents thereof from the concerned authorities i.e. Revenue Department / DAE Unit.
2. Parents of the wards of Central/State Govt/PSU employees engaged in DAE activities and/or working for the DAE applying under ND-2 category have to furnish a copy of their posting order along with the latest salary slip. The duly filled in application form has to be submitted to the school authorities after obtaining the counter signature of the administrative authorities of local DAE unit.
3. Parents of wards of employees of the major contractors working for DAE units applying under ND-2 category have to furnish a copy of their posting order along with the latest salary slip. The duly filled in application form has to be submitted to the school authorities after obtaining the counter signature of the administrative authorities of local DAE unit.
4. Wards of defence personnel or wards of their widows applying under ND-2 category should submit the documentary proof stating that their parents are/were defence personnel. They should also submit the proof of residence.
5. Parents of wards who belong to ND-4 category should submit the proof of residence.
6. Non-DAE parents of all the aforesaid categories have to furnish latest salary certificate issued by employers concerned in original or latest income certificate in original issued by the Revenue / DAE authorities along with the application.
7. Immediately after obtaining the admission, parents are requested to collect back the original birth certificate while submitting an attested copy of birth certificate in the school for record.
8. Photocopy of the last Report Card of the class for which annual examination was given .
9. Photocopy of residence allotment letter issued by the concerned DAE Unit allotment section, wherever applicable.
10. Attested photocopy of the caste certificate (issued by competent authority i.e SDO/Tahsildar) **in the name of the student** has to be furnished in order to avail fee concession. Caste certificate of the parent shall not be considered.
11. Latest pay slip, if seeking fee concessions, should be attested by the constituent DAE authorities and should be produced at the time of payment of fees.
12. Parents seeking admission under Non-DAE category are required to submit an affidavit/undertaking from a regular UCIL employee stating that the employee will pay the fee in case the Non-DAE parent fails to pay the fees.
